

APU CODE OF CONDUCT



ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY



Apex Professional University (APU), Arunachal Pradesh is a statutory university established by an Act (No. 7 of 2013) of State Legislature of Arunachal Pradesh, which received the assent of His Excellency, the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh on May 08th, 2013 and published in the Arunachal Pradesh gazette vide Notification No. LAW/LEGN17/2012 Dated 10th May, 2013. APU is located at the eastern foothills of the divine Himalayas, in Pasighat, Arunachal Pradesh that is spiritually vibrant, naturally serene and peaceful.

The University Grants Commission (UGC) has enlisted Apex Professional University (APU) as a state private university vide its letter F. No. 8-13/2013(CPP-I/PU) dated 28th June 2013 in accordance with section 2(f) of UGC Act. The University is also empowered to grant the Diplomas, Certificates, Pre University Certificates (Secondary and Senior Secondary Level) and other academic distinctions in conformity with the provisions of the Apex Professional University Act (No. 7 of 2013), Statutes and Regulations notified by Government of Arunachal Pradesh in the Official Gazette

The Apex Professional University Act 2012 provides that the University is empowered to register external (private) students in different courses as per the university norms. The University offers Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) giving freedom to the students to choose his/her optional courses.

ABOUT ARUNACHAL PRADESH



Arunachal Pradesh, meaning "Land of the Rising Sun," for long has been a recognized region of the Indian sub-continent, receiving mention in such Ancient Indian literature as the Kalika-purana & the epics Mahabharata & Ramayana. Formerly known as the North East Frontier Agency (from the British colonial era), the area was part of Assam until it was made the Indian Union Territory of Arunachal Pradesh in 1972, & in 1987 it became an Indian state.

Arunachal Pradesh constitutes a mountainous area in the extreme northeastern part of the country & is bordered by the kingdom of Bhutan to the west, the Tibet Autonomous Region of China to the north, Myanmar (Burma) & the Indian state of Nagaland to the south & southeast, & the Indian state of Assam to the south & southwest.

Smart City: Pasighat is the oldest town of Arunachal Pradesh, founded in 1911 A.D. by the British as a gateway to administrative convenience of the greater Abor Hills and the north area in general. Nestled along the shores of beautiful mighty Siang River (also known as the Brahmaputra), Pasighat sits as the 'Gateway to Arunachal Pradesh' & it is blessed with an enchanting scenic beauty of lush forests, majestic mountains, sparkling waterfalls & splendidly gorgeous hanging bridges.

Pasighat is the education capital of Arunachal Pradesh. The significant development in Pasighat that came after that was the Apex Professional University being established on 10th May 2013. The Government of India included Pasighat in the Smart Cities Mission development scheme in June, 2017. Pasighat is well connected by Air, train and bus from Guwahati. With the inauguration of Bogibeel bridge over river Brahmaputra, it will be a journey of 2-3 hours from Dibrugarh.



SALIENT FEATURES OF THE UNIVERSITY

INNOVATIVE PROGRAMMES & CURRICULAR FRAMEWORK: Guided by the National Education Policy 2020 and learning from the experiences of the best universities of the world, the University has introduced a number of innovations, as detailed below:

A. Semester System: Semester system is followed for all academic programme (except where regulatory bodies have prescribed other systems) to enlarge curricular space and encourage accelerated learning opportunities at par with global practices in terms of effective number of teaching days and teaching learning synergy. This system further enhances the ability to accommodate diverse choices that are dynamic and can motivate students as they may like to have. As per requirements of an academic programme; decisions regarding student faculty contact hours during a semester in different programmes, developing the credit system, determining the quantum of learning, time-distribution on classroom work, elements of participatory teaching-learning synergy, fieldwork, lab-work and other curricular activities are taken by the academic bodies of the University.

B. Choice Based Credit System (CBCS): The University has introduced Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) largely on the lines of the best universities of the world. Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) has some unique features like enhanced learning opportunities, ability to match student's scholastic needs and aspirations, horizontal intra and inter School/ Centre mobility of students, inter-institutional transferability of students, improvement in educational quality and excellence, flexibility for working students to complete the programme over an extended period of time, innovation and comparability of educational programmes across the country. CBCS will facilitate vertical integration of knowledge & holistic development.

C. Programmes of Study are defined in terms of Credits: As opposed to papers/courses in the conventional system, a student shall be required to accumulate:

- 20 DP credits to earn a Certificate
- 40 DP credits to earn a Diploma Trade Certificate
- 80 UG credits to earn an Advanced Diploma /Industrial Trade Certificate
- 120 UG credits to earn a UG Degree
- 40 PG credits to earn a PG Diploma
- 80 PG credits to earn a PG Degree
- 120 RD credits to earn a Ph.D. Degree

D. Students to accumulate required number of credit from across disciplines: The inter disciplinary approach in the selection of courses is followed with 70 percent courses from the faculty and 30 percent from other schools/faculty of the university. In case of School of Business and Management Science, students would be offered 30 percent Courses University wise; 40 percent School wise and 30 percent faculty wise.

E. Innovative approach in designing programmes of Study: Departments would design programmes of Study on the basis of:

- Design and offer courses, based on the expertise and specialization of their faculty members;
- Specify pre-requisite and core requisites for each course offered;
- Guide the students to make their own basket of courses to accumulate the required credits to complete their programme of Study. Thus, the focus is on '**learner-centered approach**' as opposed to the conventional 'teacher-centered approach') to accommodate learner's needs and expectations to have wider choices in content, mode & pace of learning.

SALIENT FEATURES OF THE UNIVERSITY

F. Computation of Credits based on a Holistic Approach to Learning:

In the Apex Professional University, one credit is defined as equivalent to the Total Student's Effort (TSE) of 30 hours comprising:

- 10 hours of lectures/organized classroom activity/contact hours;
- 5 hours of laboratory work/practical/ field work/tutorials/teacher-led activities/quiz/debate;
- 15 hours of other work load such as independent individual/group work; obligatory/optional work placement; literature survey / library work; data collection/ field work; writing of papers/projects/ dissertation/thesis; seminars, etc. Thus, the focus is on in-depth learning driven by intrinsic curiosity and mastery of the subject by balancing the taught content with independent self-directed learning.

G. All Programmes of Study to be Modular: All Programmes of Study in the University are designed as modular with exit and lateral entry option. While most Students may want to complete their UG/PG/RD without any break, some may opt out of the Programme of Study midway due to their personal compelling reasons. The University, therefore, provides a structured framework for students to opt out mid-programme, whereby, depending on the extent of time spent on study and credits accumulated by them, they will be awarded certificate / diploma / advanced diploma / PG diploma. For instance, if any student wants to quit study after successful completion of one/two/four semester(s), she/he can do so and would be awarded an appropriate Certificate/ Diploma and can rejoin and continue her/his study from this point within two years again. Thus, the **multi entry and multi exit** programmes are the unique and useful features of our university.

(i) A Student admitted to UG Programme may get:

- Certificate (if opts out after 1 Semester with 20 UG Credits);
- Diploma (if opts out after 2 Semesters with 40 UG Credits);
- Advance Diploma (if opts out after 4 Semesters with 80 UG Credits);
- Bachelor's Degree (if stays on to complete full 6 Semesters with 120 UG Credits).

(ii) A Student Admitted to PG Programme may get:

- PG Diploma (if opts out after 2 Semesters with 40 PG credits);
- Master Degree (if stays on for full 4 Semesters with 80 PG Credits).
Those who thus opt out would be eligible to join laterally to complete and earn their degree, if they return to the university within the next two years. (Subject to the availability of the course)

H. All Programmes of Study to have Grading System: The University shall have grading system based on six-point scale of evaluation of the performances of students in terms of marks, grade points, letter grade and class. The total performances of a student within a semester and continuous performance from the second semester onwards shall be indicated by (a) Grade Point Average (GPA); (b) Weighted Average Marks (WAM); (c) Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA); and (d) Overall Weighted Percentage Marks (OWPM).

I. Comprehensive Continuous Evaluation System: Comprehensive Continuous Assessment' is the central feature of the evaluation system of this University. A teacher who handles the course is the best person to assess performance of the students. However, there is end semester evaluation and to ensure transparency, fair play and accountability, appropriate mechanisms have been devised. Students in all Programmes of Study across disciplines and at all levels shall be assessed through Comprehensive Continuous Assessment based on quizzes, assignments, Independent works, group works, mid-semester and end-semester examination. As a general principle, the Continuous Assessment shall be as below except as prescribed by the concerned council and comprise the following components:

SALIENT FEATURES OF THE UNIVERSITY

INDUSTRY-INTEGRATED:

As a university dedicated to skill development and that helps build a high quality workforce in India, APU ensures that its programmes are well-developed with real-world relevance that meet industry needs. To achieve this, APU forges strong collaborations with established organizations to identifying new courses, designing curricula, facilitating hands-on training to the students, sponsoring research as well as employees for higher degree programmes and providing senior managers as visiting and mentor faculty at the University, so that our university can become a job provider rather than job seeker.

TECHNOLOGY-BASED:

The University uses cutting-edge technology in all its functions and activities, such as content development, teaching-learning pedagogies, evaluation and testing, learning and university management (eGovernance).

RESEARCH-DRIVEN:

The University supports and promotes research excellence in its many forms. World class universities are about creating and using knowledge to make a difference. The Apex Professional University (APU) achieves this by bringing together excellent students, staff and external partners to identify and address key issues of the day. Immersion in a research culture equips us with a mind set for solving problems across all walks of life. Recognizing the importance of this, APU has designed each programme to expose students to the culture of research.

HOLISTIC EDUCATION:

The University understands that education is far more than just simply providing students with professional knowledge. Thus, the University is devoted to delivering all round education that fosters spiritual, intellectual, humane, social and physical development of our students,

nurturing them to become confident, caring leaders who possess integrity, perseverance and sense responsibility for themselves and others.

NATIONAL CHARACTER:

It shall be the endeavor of the University to maintain an all-India character and high standards of teaching and research, and the University shall, among the measures which may be necessary for the said purpose, take, in particular, the following measures:

A. Admission of students shall be made on all- India basis strictly on merit adjudged either through Common Entrance Tests conducted individually by the University or in combination with other Universities, or on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying examination in such courses where the intake of students is small.

B. Recruitment of faculty shall be made on an all-India basis and Inter-university mobility of faculty, with portable provident fund and protection of seniority, shall be encouraged.

INFRASTRUCTURE AND AMBIENCE: All appropriate steps are taken to create and maintain the state of the art infrastructure for quality teaching and research as per present day Requirements.

PSYCHOLOGICAL COUNSELLING AND GUIDANCE SERVICES:


RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING:

APU places below the three major learning styles and ways in which the curriculum is designed.

Visual Learning Style (VLS)

Visual Learning Style has a preference for seen or observed things, including pictures, diagrams, demonstrations, displays, handouts, films, flip-chart, etc. These students will use phrases such as 'MAY I SEE IT', 'let's have a look at that' and will be able to give their best and / or perform a new task after reading the instructions or watching someone else doing it first. These are the students who will work from listed and guided directions and instructions. They are more likely to understand it and recall it better later.

Auditory Learning Style (ALS)

Auditory Learning Style has a preference for the

sharing of information through listening, to the spoken words, of self or others, of sounds and noises. These Students will use phrases such as 'tell me', 'let's talk it over' & will be best able to perform a new task after listening to instructions from an expert. These are the students whose comfort level in the classroom is high with spoken instructions & can recollect or retrieve all the information for their enhanced learning. Students learn best by listening to music, video clips, conversations, lectures & contributing to discussions.

Kinesthetic Learning Style (KLS)

Kinesthetic learning style has a preference for physical experience - touching, feeling, holding, doing, practical hands-on experiences. These students will use phrases such as 'let me try', 'how do you feel?' and will be best able to perform a new task by going ahead and trying it out, learning as they progress. These are the students who like to experiment, hands-on, and never look at the instructions first!

GURUKUL ACADEMIC SYSTEM

FIVE QUALITIES OF A STUDENT

In the whole world, Indian Knowledge System is the oldest culture. The basic principle of its transmission from one generation to the next is the gurukul education, the parampara (lineage) of Guru – disciple relationship. A student in the gurukul should pay his attention only to studies. If he directs his interest in many other things, his study will not be successful and he will not become learned and wise. A student should always try to understand what the meaning of the teachings which he or she gets from the acharya is. Like in the following story.

A guru instructed his disciple who was a bit dull to guard a pot with yogurt from crows. The disciple took a wooden stick and sat down by the pot. When some crow came near, he would chase it away. But when a cat came, he freely let it eat the entire yogurt from it. After some time Guruji returned and, upon seeing the empty pot, started inquiring about the yogurt. The boy answered that he was protecting it from crows but then a cat came and ate all of it. "And why didn't you chase it away," Guruji asked. "Because I was told to guard it only from crows," was the answer. That is not the way to understand our teaching, it is blind.

To become a good student, one should follow the precepts laid down by the Vedas:

Kaak cheshta Bako dhyanam
Swan nindra tathaiwa cha
Alpahari graihatyagi
Vidyarthi panch lakshanam

काक चेष्टा, बको ध्यानं,
स्वान निद्रा तथैव च।
अल्पहारी, गृहत्यागी,
विद्यार्थी पंच लक्षणं॥

Have the awareness of a crow (remember the story of a crow, rising the level of water in a pot by putting pebble into it) who is always aware of everything around it, where and what appears to eat, to steal etc), have the concentration like a crane (who stands motionless at the bank of a lake and when a fish is passing by, it quickly catches it), have shallow sleep like a dog (who immediately wakes up if anyone comes close), always eat limited quantities of food (fill half of your stomach with food, a quarter with water and leave one quarter empty) and renounce the attachment to your house and family (do not call home every weekend and narrate long stories of how you are, what you were eating, what your friends do and so on). These are the five signs of a good student.




GURUKUL ACADEMIC FRAMEWORK




Sadvidya - Value Education

APST STIPEND SCHEME

- **Pre-Requisites for the grant of Stipend:** Satisfactory Progress, Regular Attendance and Good Conduct are the mandatory pre-requisites for the grant of stipend
- **The Stipends will not be extended to the Students:** Who are found guilty of misconduct / participate in strike / irregularity in attendance / commit offences /break University and hostel discipline.

Note: Stipend is disbursed by Directorate of Higher & Technical Education Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh. The University Management will not entertain the queries related to irregularities or non-receipt of Stipend under any circumstances.

POST MATRIC SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME

The Post Matric Scholarship scheme is a Centrally Sponsored scheme implemented by State Government and Union Territory Administrations. 100% Central assistance over and above the committed liability of the State Governments / UTs Admin from the Government of India. The State Government and UT admin to which the applicant belongs awards the scholarship.

Eligibility:

- Scholarship are paid to students whose parents / guardians's income from all sources does not exceed Rs. 2.50 lakh per annum.
- The Scholarships are available for the study of all recognized post matriculation or post-secondary course.
- The scholarship holder under this scheme will not hold any other scholarship/stipend.

Note: Post Matric Scholarship is disbursed by the Govt. of India through Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh. The University Management will not entertain the queries related to irregularities or non-receipt of Post Matric Scholarship under any circumstances.

CHANCELLOR'S SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME

The University offers scholarships to meritorious candidates based on her / his academic performance in qualifying examinations prescribed by the university, viz 10+2 or Graduation, rank/score in All India / State Level Entrance / Aptitude Test and candidates possessing exemplary skills in sports, performing arts or literature.

- 85% tuition fee waiver for toppers of all Boards / Universities.
- 50% tuition fee waiver as scholarship for students securing 90% marks in qualifying examination or Sikh Minority students.
- 30% tuition fee waiver as scholarship for students

securing 80% marks in qualifying examination.


- 30% tuition fee waiver as scholarship for students with gold or silver medal at the national level / state level in sports or having some exemplary achievements to their credit in the area of performing arts or literature.
- 20% tuition fee waiver as a scholarship to the ST-SC, OBC & Minority Category Students.

MERIT SCHOLARSHIP DURING A PROGRAM

In order to encourage students to achieve better performance during their studies in an academic program, the university institutes merit scholarships for them in recognition of their academic achievements in the concerned programs of study. These scholarships are awarded every semester from the second semester onwards, after the declaration of the results, for a period of one semester by Scholarship Management Committee of the University as per APU rules.



In modern terminology research is termed as intellectual capital of a person, institution or a society. It is a challenge in solving the unsolved and unidentified problems. Research is composed of two syllables, re and search, re is a prefix meaning again / a new and search is a suffix meaning to examine closely systematic patient study and investigation in some field of knowledge undertaken to establish facts or principles.

Research activities are normally composed of two main aspects the production of theoretical knowledge and an integral experiential encounter with subjects constituting the society. Indeed, the body of published material built up by hundreds of researcher-writers and creation of a massive data base from which to retrieve information regularly and which is constantly augmented, corrected and revised is a natural corollary of research activities. This body of published material and the data base constitute the research canon that is central to the functioning of a reputed academic institution like APU and that forms a material expression of its scholarship.

A principal objective of APU's Research Programme has been to maintain a strong focus on the flow of theoretical ideas and to connect it with the empirical works of subject oriented researches in sciences, social sciences, humanities, management, technology and other disciplines offered by the University as areas of probe and investigation from time to time. There has to be a conjunctive mix of theoretical ideas and extended probes into concrete social situations. It is now commonly agreed that the object of the subject/discipline oriented research is to delineate a methodology of investigation that guarantees the discovery of 'truth' and to prescribe that methodology as canonical imperatives which practicing researchers are obliged to follow.

Our research programme has indeed great practical import and impact; studying the philosophy of research and training into research methods have become important ingredients of our research programme.

CENTER OF EXCELLENCE FOR INDIAN KNOWLEDGE SYSTEM

INDIAN civilization has always attached great value to knowledge - witness its amazingly large body of intellectual texts, the world's largest collection of manuscripts, its attested tradition of texts, thinkers and schools in so many domains of knowledge. Three terms are closely connected in all discussions of knowledge - Darshana, Gyana and Vidya. Darshana, philosophy is the "system," the point of view, which yields / leads to Gyana, knowledge. When knowledge gathered about a particular domain is organized and systematized for purposes of, say, reflection and pedagogy, it is called Vidya, "discipline."

The entire body of organized knowledge is divided into two sets - Para Vidya and Apar Vidya. The first kind of knowledge is observational and is gained by the Indriya (Senses); the other is experiential and is gained by the inner self as drashta. In one, the whole cognizing self is "baharmukhi" directed towards and involved in the outer world; in the other, the whole cognizing self is "antarmukhi", (turned inwards). To acquire the first kind of knowledge, only the sensory apparatus, including the mind, has to be prepared, but to acquire the second kind of knowledge the knower has to go through a process of preparation, Sadhana, (for knowledge-acquisition).

In the Indian tradition, knowledge has been constituted, stored and maintained in the framework of the oral culture. According to Bhartrhari, knowledge is constituted in our inner self. There is the "antargyan", constituted by the input of the senses {indriya}, processed by the mind {mana} and the intellect (buddhi), and finally constituted knowledge exists as our transformed, alert self, chitta (Vakypadiya).

If the Registration Form of external candidate is received after the prescribed date, candidate shall pay late fee as prescribed.


